Kirisun PT4200 Analogue Professional UHF Radio For Hire

	<p>The Kirisun PT4200 analogue UHF radio is one of our standard walkie-talkie radios for hire.</p> <p>We have several hundred of these available for both short and long term hire.</p> <p>It is a compact, and reliable walkie-talkie offering the highest power available in a UHF radio, and offers good range and good signal propagation within and amongst buildings.</p> <p>It has 4 watts power output, and it also has a strong spring-loaded belt-clip on the back.</p> <p>It is extremely simple to use – just an ON/OFF/VOLUME knob and a rotary channel selector to choose one of the sixteen available channels.</p> <p>The battery pack will usually last for 15 – 25 hours depending on how much transmitting is done. We can provide spare battery packs for a small extra charge.</p> <p>Weight: 215g</p> <p>Size (body): 115mm x 60mm x 36mm Antenna length: 100mm</p>
	<p>When you hire six or more of these walkie-talkies, we will usually provide 6-slot charger units instead of single chargers. The multi-chargers are quite small and light, around the “footprint” of this sheet of A4 paper.</p> <p>Coloured LEDs indicate the charging progress of each walkie-talkie. The chargers can also be used to charge spare battery packs separately from the radios, so you need never run out of power when you need it.</p> <p>The six slot chargers drastically reduce the number of mains sockets needed to charge a lot of radios at one time.</p>

Below are some more pictures of our standard Kirisun PT4200 walkie-talkie hire radio.

A radio is shown here next to a soft drink can, to show its size.

The radios are very simple to use with just a rotary on/off and volume control and a rotary channel selector.

They also have a strong spring-loaded belt-clip on the back so the user can attach the radio to their belt or pocket.

There is a socket to plug in earpiece/ microphones and headsets etc.



Our radios are supplied with chargers, usually the compact, A4-page sized 6-slot charger shown above. The above photo shows the 6-slot charger sitting on a sheet of A4 paper.



We can also provide spare batteries if necessary, that can be charged separately from the radios, so that you can have a charged-up battery ready to be quickly swapped for a "flat" battery to keep your radios in use 24/7 if required.



We have vehicle radios and base stations that will inter-operate with the PT4200 walkie-talkies.
